RECYCFLUO - PRODUCT LIST COVERED BY PHASE II -

The following table lists "recycling fee" rates for Phase II of the RecycFluo program. Since October 1st, 2013, ecofees apply to mercury-containing lamps incorporated into all types of fixtures or automobiles on a per unit basis. Affected lighting fixtures are defined as electrical/electronic lighting products with a primary purpose of illuminating a space that contains one or more replaceable mercury-containing lamps, including hardwired, freestanding and portable products.

As of October 1, 2013, members are required to report the ecofees for each mercury lamp sold as a component in a fixture or automobile:

Examples

A/ A member selling a street lighting fixture containing one HID lamp will be required to report and remit one HID fee to the program on the sale of that fixture.

B / A member selling an automobile with two integrated HID headlamps would pay two HID fees on the sale of that automobile.

The fee rates for component mercury-containing lamps are the same as the fee rates applied to replaceable mercury containing lamps sold individually. Mercury-containing lamps that are integrated into luminaries/automobiles and replacement mercury-containing lamps sold individually must be reported jointly, without distinction.

Example:

If a member sold, during the same reporting period, 300 HID lamps as replaceable/individual lamps and 100 fixtures with a single, integrated HID lamp within each, the member would report 400 HID lamps for that reporting period.

Below is a non-exhaustive list of examples of luminaires that can be sold with mercury lamps. It is the responsibility of each member to review their fixtures and report sales of mercury-containing lamps incorporated into their fixtures, not just those listed as examples.

If members identify any additional lighting fixture type sold with an integrated mercury-containing lamp, which has not been included in this list, we ask that they contact RecycFluo so it can be added to the example product list.
